Garland Road and Buckner Intersection Update

Construction of the proposed road expansion at the intersection of Garland Road (State Hwy. 78) and Buckner Boulevard has been delayed until April 2004 while the state and city continue to try to acquire the necessary right-of-way. The project will include dual left turn only lanes in all directions, three thru lanes, and right turn "decompression" lanes in all directions. That equates to nine lanes of traffic to cross if you want to go from our neighborhood to the "jewels" of east Dallas, Casa Linda Shopping Center and White Rock Lake. In addition, the existing landscaping on all four corners will be destroyed with the addition of these lanes. Several neighbors are working with the state, county and city to explore pedestrian friendly solutions to this project, and also to explore sources of funding for beautification and landscaping improvements.

 Quarterly General Meeting Minutes

Amendment 1

There shall be at least four (4) general meetings each year. The time and place of three (3) of the general meetings shall be on the 4th Thursday of the month of January, April, and July at 7:00 p.m. at such place as the vice-president shall have arranged and announced in the newsletter. The forth meeting shall be held on a Saturday chosen at the boards discretion in either the months of September or October at such other place as board of directors shall have arranged and announced in the newsletter.

Amendment 2

If the President of the past year is not seeking re-election and is so inclined, he shall be automatically appointed, without election, to one of the MEMBER-AT-LARGE positions on the board of directors and shall be referred to as the PAST PRESIDENT. This appointment shall not alter the number of allowed MEMBERS-AT-LARGE as stated within these by-laws.
