## A Letter from the President

Neighbors,

Your neighborhood association is fighting crime.

In early October, we had our first ever National Night Out event. Councilman Kadane and a representative from Dallas Police visited a large group of neighbors.

We will shortly kick off a Volunteers In Patrol (VIP) program. Several neighbors are VIP trained through the Dallas Police Department. Soon they will start occasional patrols of the neighborhood.

In the next few months, we will start a neighborhood directory project. This will have two purposes: a printed directory to help you know your neighbors and information that VIP patrollers can use to contact you if anything is amiss.

The crime camera committee continues its work. It is still tuning the pilot camera, and a second camera should go up soon.

Our email lists help disseminate breaking crime information. If you're not on an LPENA email list, email me at [aren@cambre.biz](mailto:aren@cambre.biz) to be added.

How you can prevent crime:

**The common sense stuff:** lock your doors, make your house look occupied when you're not home, own a loud dog, set your alarm, etc.

**Install a NO SOLICITING sign on your front door.** Many potential burglars knock only to check whether anyone is home. Since NO SOLICITING signs are backed up by Dallas law, we can report those ignoring the signs to the police. Don't worry about passing on opportunities: "door to door" is not a legitimate sales channel.

## What's New In Canine Pain Management? NSAID LED by Jennifer Lavender

Osteoarthritis is probably the most common disease subjecting dogs to chronic pain. You and your veterinarian are faced with several options for managing such pain. NSAID's, or Non Steroidal Anti-inflammatories, are often part of this management plan.

This class of drugs works to reduce the signs of osteoarthritis by decreasing inflammation, swelling, stiffness, and joint pain. There are, however, side effects associated with this class of medication. Such adverse affects include anorexia, vomiting, or diarrhea. They can also cause liver or kidney problems.

The goal is to select drugs that are effective at doses low enough to avoid side effects. Many human NSAID's, such as aspirin, are effective in dogs. However, the dosage required to provide pain relief with this NSAID will likely also cause adverse effects. We are fortunate to have multiple choices of NSAID's available that are labeled for use in dogs. The medications are effective at doses low enough to reduce the risk of adverse effects. Examples of such NSAID's include Rimadyl, Etogesic, Deramax, and Metacam.

None of this is ground breaking news, and anyone whose dog has osteoarthritis likely already knows all of this. What is new, however, about NSAID therapy is a renewed commitment to LED – or Lowest Effective Dosing. LED is the practice of titrating a dog's daily dosage down to the lowest dose that will still control his/her pain. The benefit of this is to even further reduce the risk of NSAID-associated side effects.

At Metro Paws Animal Hospital, LLC, we try to educate our clients on the risks and benefits of this class of medication. Bloodwork is required throughout NSAID therapy to monitor liver and kidney function. We also counsel our clients on how to find the LED for their pet. If needed, we can change dogs from a pill to a liquid NSAID (metacam) to make reduction of a dog's daily dosage to LED more convenient. 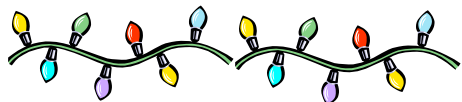

### Waterford Circle Awaits New Look

The LPENA board recently approved a rehabilitation project for Waterford Circle, the traffic island at Waterford Drive and Tranquilla Drive.

Around 10 years ago, volunteers enhanced the circle with new plants and other landscaping features. The circle has since become weedy and overgrown.

The new Waterford Circle will feature up to seven white flowering (Natchez) crepe myrtles shading mulched ground. The elegant and low-maintenance redesign will be more compatible with adjacent properties, reduce clutter, enhance views, and make the circle more aesthetically similar to Galway Circle.

The project is being directed by Ann Allen, LPE resident and professional horticulturalist. The project will require removal of all plants except for the existing crepe myrtle and presents several volunteer opportunities for site preparation, planting, and first year maintenance.
